

# Insights into the study

The Master's program in Theology and Ethics in Social and Health Care is divided into 10 modules. The following selection should give you a first idea of some examplitied modules:

#### **Example: Entry-level modules**

The question of God

The module imparts a sound basic knowledge of the Old Testament image of God and of the revelation of God in life, work and message of Jesus. From the perspective of philosophy, the possibilities of recognizing God and speaking about God are also illuminated in a fundamental way.

#### **Example: Mandatory modules**

*Fundamentals of Leadership and Management* The module provides insights into leadership styles and organizational models, concrete techniques and methods for project planning, development of staff and organization and much more.

#### Example: Practical training + Master thesis

Master thesis, internship and workshops

The workshops impart advanced methodological, technical and social skills. The internship provides an in-depth insight into future fields of work and serves as the basis for the master's thesis.
